**Consent to Revocation Proceeding by
Video Teleconferencing or Telephone Conferencing**

Because of the national emergency created by the novel coronavirus, the judge can conduct my revocation proceeding by video teleconferencing (or telephone conferencing if video teleconferencing is not reasonably available) if I consent after talking to my lawyer.

I understand that I may insist the judge conduct the revocation proceeding with me present and in person within a reasonable time. But after talking to my lawyer, I consent to having the judge conduct my revocation proceeding by video teleconferencing (or by telephone conferencing if video teleconferencing is not reasonably available).

I am voluntarily consenting. No one has forced me, threatened me, coerced me, intimidated me, or promised me anything to get me to provide this consent. I am getting no benefit from this consent except perhaps a sooner date for the revocation proceeding.
