MOTION FOR MODIFICATION OF SYSTEM OF COLLATERAL FORFEITURE FOR PETTY OFFENSE VIOLATIONS OF THE VETERANS AFFAIRS

COMES NOW The United States of America, by and through its undersigned Assistant United States Attorney, respectfully request that this Court modify its order entered March 14, 1986, Docket No. Misc.-OC-86-43, which established the collateral forfeiture schedule for violations of regulations of the Veterans Affairs (previously known as Veterans Administration), and in support offers the following:

- 1. The present collateral forfeiture schedule was established in March of 1986. Since that time the cost of issuing and processing offense citations has risen while the collateral forfeiture amounts have remained the same. Accordingly, the present collateral forfeiture amounts provide an insufficient deterrent to repeated violations.
- 2. The collateral forfeiture schedule proposed by the United States is intended to enhance compliance with the Veterans Affairs regulations by balancing deterrence and efficient use of law enforcement and judicial resources.

The following changes have been made in this proposed collateral forfeiture system:

1. The fines in fourteen offenses have been changed; these changes are indicated in the attached list by an asterisk "\*"; the old fine is in parentheses.

2. Mandatory appearance will be required for three offenses that previously offered of forfeiture of collateral. These are indicated by "MANDATORY APPEARANCE"; the old fine is in parentheses.
