The panel must review Magistrate Judge Flynn's and Magistrate Judge Tuite's performance and comments received in response to the public notice of reappointment, and the panel may interview Magistrate Judge Flynn and/or Magistrate Judge Tuite. No later than **June 2, 2025**, the panel must make a recommendation to the Court whether to reappoint Magistrate Judge Flynn for another term and whether to appoint Magistrate Tuite for another term. The Court has notified each panel member in writing of the one-year restriction

on a panel member's subsequent application for a magistrate judgeship. See Guide to Judiciary Policy, Vol. 3, Ch. 4, § 420.30.20(d).

The Clerk of Court must publish notice of the Middle District of Florida's consideration of the reappointment and shall assist the panel as needed.
