ORDER

This cause is before the Court sua sponte regarding assignment of civil cases seeking a stay of execution or challenging the method of execution in state death penalty cases. Upon receipt of any civil action seeking to stay an execution or challenging the method of execution filed in any division, the Clerk is directed to search the Plaintiff's/Petitioner's name for previous habeas corpus filings. If a previous habeas case has been filed in this district, the Clerk shall forthwith transfer the civil case to the division within the Middle District of Florida where the previous habeas action was or is being addressed. Further, the civil case should be assigned to the Judge to whom the original habeas action was assigned. If the assigned Judge is no longer an active Judge in the Middle District of Florida, the case should be transferred to the division where the habeas action was or is being addressed and be assigned according to historical divisional case transfers and reassignments or from a random rotating death penalty assignment list. The transferring Clerk should ensure that all appropriate personnel in the transferee division are notified of the transferred case and the need for immediate action by the Court.
