**Public Notice for the Reappointment of  
Magistrate Judge Anthony E. Porcelli**

United States Magistrate Judge Anthony E. Porcelli's term expires on August 7, 2025. As required by law, the Middle District of Florida has established a merit selection panel to consider the reappointment of Judge Porcelli to an eight-year term in Tampa, Florida.

The duties of a United States Magistrate Judge, specified in 28 U.S.C. § 636, include conducting most preliminary proceedings in criminal cases, trying misdemeanor cases, conducting pretrial matters and evidentiary proceedings after delegation from a district judge, and trying civil cases with the consent of the litigants.
